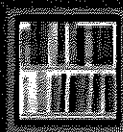

This site offers access to over 10,000 ebooks, educational videos, links to additional educational websites, online content used by college students for research. Teachers can access their online teacher materials and students can access their online textbooks and resources for math, science, social studies and Spanish. The Purdue Online Writing Lab (OWL) is a site to help students write and cite papers and more.

The new resource that I think is so great is the EBSCO Learning Express which is a site for College Prep, STAAR EOC Prep, Career Exploration, Job & Career Accelerator plus tutorials and practice with SAT, ACT and ASVAB tests and much, much more.

Also on the new website is the TBHS online library. All of the books and other library materials are now available for patrons to browse at their convenience. In an effort for school and community to work together and to give our students and teachers more choices, Roberta Bumpus, (former TBISD teacher, librarian, curriculum director, Asst. Superintendent) the current librarian at the Tom Bean Lucile Teague Library has given permission to add that library's online catalog to our website.
